THIRU V.ARUN ROY, I.A.S., THE MANAGING DIRECTOR, CHENNAI METROPOLITAN WATER SUPPLY & SEWERAGE BOARD HAS STOPPED A METROWATER HIRED TANKER LORRY FOR SUPPLYING WATER TO A CONSTRUCTION SITE ILLEGALLY.

Thiru V.Arun Roy, I.A.S., the Managing Director, C.M.W.S.S. Board has been inspecting water supply, sewerage collection works and drought contingency works in Greater Chennai City area for ensuring quality services to the residents.

On this process, 07.03.2017(Tuesday), the Managing Director has inspected the works in Valasaravakkam area and noticed a Metrowater hired water tanker lorry bearing Regn. No.TN-12B-8022 was supplying water to a construction site at Mount-Poonthamallee Road, illegally. The Managing Director has immediately ordered to suspend the above lorry from Service henceforth. Further, the Managing Director has also warned that severe action would be taken on the Boards hired tanker lorries involving such illegal water supply in future.
