

ACTION TAKEN BY CMWSS BOARD TO MEET THE ENSUING NORTH-EAST MONSOON

CMWSSB have taken meticulous measures to tackle the ensuing Northeast monsoon and have made the following preparedness.

As a precautionary measure the entire sewer system is being desilted by special preventive maintenance program by using the sewer cleaning equipments such as Jet Rodding machine (113 nos), Super sucker (43 nos), Jetting cum suction machine (30 nos) and Desilting machine (239 nos).

The damaged manhole covers are being identified and replaced.

Arrangements have been made to run Sewage Pumping Stations continuously even during power failure using Generators.

Water Quality is intensively monitored at all locations. The Quality Assurance Wing has increased the number of sampling from 100 to 150 locations and bacteriological testing from 30 to 50 locations per day as a precautionary measure for the ensuing monsoon. Residual chlorine test has been escalated from 2000 samples per day to 3000 samples per day.

Adequate quantities of chemicals like Alum, Bleaching powder, Hypochlorite solution, Chlorine gas and Chlorine tablets are made available in all Water Treatment Plants, Water Distribution Stations.

Senior level Nodal officers have been posted in each area to monitor the monsoon preparedness work.

One Central Complaint Cell with contact number 45674567 is functioning 24x7 at Head Office located at No.1, Pumping Station Road, Chintadripet, Chennai - 2 to receive the complaints from the public and convey to the respective locations for rectifying the same.

CMWSSB is prepared to arrange water supply to the relief camps on the request from Corporation of Chennai.
